COVID-19/CORONAVIRUS INFORMATION

March 15, 2020

Dear Beekman Residents,

The Town of Beekman has been working in conjunction with Dutchess County Dept. of Behavioral and Community Health, Emergency Response as well as County Executive Marcus Molinaro to plan and prepare for the COVID-19/Coronavirus here in our community. With the declaration of COVID-19 as a pandemic and confirmed cases in Dutchess County, Government Agencies are recommending the suspension of any community and social gatherings over 20 people, as a precautionary measure. We will be implementing that recommendation immediately through April 5th. This guidance will be updated and revisited regularly over the coming days and weeks. This suspension will include: Senior Programs, Beekman Recreation Programs & Events. All postponements will be posted on Beekman's websites and social media pages. Please refer to the Town's website for scheduling updates on events, programs, and meetings.

Town offices will remain open until further notice. We would like to have town offices opened for *Essential Services* to continue with as little disruption as possible. Please phone or email specific departments for further instructions. Please refrain from entering any town facilities unnecessarily especially if you have any symptoms of an illness or you have been out of the country in the last 14 days. We request these considerations for town employees' benefit as well as other residents who need to conduct business with the town.

Decisions as to whether any public meetings will be cancelled will be made on a case-by-case basis. In the event there is a postponement or cancellation, a notice will be posted online and in the Town Hall.

We will make every effort to keep you up-to-date on information as it develops.
