BEEKMAN TOWN BOARD MEETING – February 11, 2020: Meeting of the Beekman Town Board was called to order at 7:02PM with Supervisor Mary Covucci presiding. The Meeting was held in the Meeting Room at Town Hall. THOSE PRESENT: SUPERVISOR MARY COVUCCI COUNCILMAN ROBERT SWARTZ COUNCILWOMAN SHARON WOHRMAN COUNCILMAN WERNER STIEGLER COUNCILMAN EZIO BATTAGLINI Supervisor Mary Covucci began the Meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and a Moment of Silence in Honor of our Troops who have served and those currently serving. Supervisor Covucci made one administrative announcement regarding the location of fire exits.

LIBRARY REPORT PRESENTED BY CAROL FORTIER: Carol had a full presentation which included a power-point regarding a survey which was conducted through Beekman Residents. GENERAL BOARD COMMENTS: COUNCILMAN BATTAGLINI provided a monthly report for the Beekman Fire Department. Councilman Battaglini reported 108 calls for the month, this equates to 4 calls per day it is made up of 16 fire calls, and 108 EMS 19 of those calls going to Greenhaven Prison.
