RE: AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF A BID FOR ADA IMPROVEMENTS TO TOWN HALL

COUNCILMAN EZIO BATTAGLINI

offers the following and moves for its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Town is desirous of making ADA improvements to Town Hall in order to make public portions of the building more accessible and ADA compliant which capital improvement project is known as the “Beekman Town Hall- Accessibility Improvement Project 2020” and will be funded in the amount of \$440,000 (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Town Board is in receipt of the Town Engineer’s estimate of work; corresponding design documents and proposed bid documents; and

WHEREAS, based upon the recommendation of the Town Engineer, the Town Board wishes to proceed with this Project; and

WHEREAS, after consideration of Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law, Chapter 43-b of the Consolidated Laws of New York as amended (the, “SEQRA ACT”) the Town Board hereby determines that this project constitutes a Type II action and therefore no further determination or procedure under SEQRA is required with respect to the Project; and

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Beekman hereby approves the capital project known as the “Beekman Town Hall- Accessibility Improvement Project” (the, “Project”) and at the recommendation of the Town Engineer, issues this order to proceed; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Project shall be funded, in the first instance, in the amount of \$440,000 in the manner as follows:

\$100,000 from 00-0397-PL-A3 CDBG

\$100,000 from 13086 CDBG

\$100,000 from 19263 State and Municipal Facilities Program (“SAM”) Grant

\$140,000 from TOB General Fund- Fund Balance; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Engineer is authorized to publicly release the proposed BID for the Project and shall make a final recommendation of award to the Town Board after its close.
